
Related activities to this field conducted by the Local Council include:


- Community Work and training in the Local Council premises

- Steering Committee
- The following members will form part of the steering committee and will meet up regularly to monitor and discuss the project's progress. Strategies have already been planned to outline the implementation process step-by-step, setting timeframes, milestones and financial parameters. Evaluations and monitoring checks have also been discussed by the steering committee.
- · Legal Representative
- Kevin Borg, acting as the Executive Secretary of the Local Council, will have the role of a legal representative, where she will be involved in the daily works of the implementation, with the assistance of the Project Management Co-ordinator. The legal representative will consult with all the members of the Steering Committee and other stakeholders, and will prepare the necessary interim monitoring reports and final reports published as part of the evaluation. Mr Kevin Borg will also be financially responsible for the project, but has the obligation to see that the implementation follows the timeframe stipulated and other contractual obligations.

All deliverables and execution will fall under the responsibility of the Legal Representative which will also include the vetting of financial payments and the processing of payments within the project parameters.






SPUR Programme

The SPUR Regeneration Action planning which has been based on the base-line study carried out by the Council for the REPAIR Project co-financed through the URBACT Programme.

SPUR develops on the principle of node activities which generate regeneration through four main principles;

I – Alternative Energy and Renewable Energy Resources for a 'better quality of Life',



 $\ensuremath{\mathrm{III}}$ – Employment and social inclusion – local jobs for local people

IV- Better mobility and access through alternative sustainable transport.

The SPUR Progamme makes reference to Malta's Operation Programme for ERDF Funding not simply because of the funding opportunities but principally because of the priorities identified which fall in line with the Lisbon Strategy and Leipzig Charter and therefore refer to sustainability of cities and communities as a cardinal factor in future development and redevelopment.






THE SITE


Wied Blandun and other Gardens

- This is a relatively contemporary garden which sits on a valley floor.
- The main aim behind this garden is to create a buffer between the main throughfare and the residential zone.
- The Garden is typically Maltese with a miscellaneous type of vegetation and tree population (Eucalyptus, Pine trees, Figs, Ficus etc...
- Other Gardens targetted; Sir Paul Boffa, Corradino Lines Ditch, Addolorata Garden Cemetery, Gaddafi Gardens, KONNEKT Project.



























OUR PROJECT OBJECTIVES
